Accomplishments

- Developed a Water Conservation Task Force and led in the formation of the Northwest Water Planning Alliance, a cooperative water supply planning initiative between municipalities and counties in the northeastern Illinois area that is served by ground water and inland surface water sources
- Provided educational seminars to keep members updated on changes to legal requirements such as the Freedom of Information and Open Meetings Acts
- Performed a leading role in protecting the Local Government Distributive Fund from attempts to divert those funds for state use
- Strengthened strategic alliances with the Counties, the Metropolitan Mayors Caucus, the Chicago Metropolitan Agency for Planning, the Illinois Municipal League and other Councils of Government
- Increased our visibility and level of influence in Springfield
- Provided task forces and study groups to share information and investigate topics such as wind energy and financial strategies for surviving in difficult economic times

COMMITTEES/TASK FORCES

Metro West committees and task forces include the Legislative Committee, the Finance Committee, the Strategic Plan Committee, the Transportation Task Force, the Water Conservation Task Force, the Membership and Programs Committee, the 911 Task Force and the Kane County Animal Control Task Force. Short term study groups are formed as needed to address issues as they arise.

PROGRAMS

Special programs and events include the Legislative Breakfast, the Springfield Drive-Down, the State of the Counties Luncheon, Orientation Seminars for Newly-Elected Officials and the Legislative Barbecue and Session Review.

COLLABORATIVE PARTNERS

Metro West works closely with the Metropolitan Mayors Caucus, other Councils of Government, the Chicago Metropolitan Agency for Planning and the Illinois Municipal League to strengthen legislative initiatives and coordinate regional planning efforts. Metro West members play leading roles in these organizations.
